## HOUSE BILL NO. 467

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. (1) The governing authorities of any 6
- municipality of this state shall not require that municipal 7
- employees maintain their domicile and principal place of residence 8
- 9 inside the corporate boundaries of the municipality or in the
- 10 county in which the municipality is located at the time of their
- employment. 11
- The governing authorities of any municipality shall not 12
- require that municipal employees obtain a residence inside the 13
- corporate boundaries of the municipality or in the county in which 14
- the municipality is located within a certain period of time or be 15
- 16 subject to termination.
- 17 The following words as used in this section shall have
- the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection unless the 18
- context clearly indicates otherwise: 19
- "Domicile" means a person's principal or primary 20
- place of abode in which a person's habitation is fixed and to 21
- which the person, whenever absent, has the present intention of 22
- returning after a departure of absence therefrom, regardless of 23
- the duration of the absence. The burden of proving domicile shall 24
- be on the person claiming that status. 25
- 26 "Residence" means the place where one actually
- lives or has his home. 27

- 28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after July 1, 2002.
