## HOUSE BILL NO. 480

- AN ACT TO REENACT SECTION 57-75-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1
- WHICH CREATES THE YELLOW CREEK REGIONAL PROJECT BOARD; TO AMEND 2
- REENACTED SECTION 57-75-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE DATE OF REPEAL ON THAT SECTION FROM JUNE 30, 2002, TO JUNE 30, 3
- 4 2003; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 57-75-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- reenacted and amended as follows: 8
- 57-75-29. (1) There is hereby created the Yellow Creek 9
- Regional Project Board which shall consist of nine (9) members 10
- appointed as follows: 11
- (a) Three (3) members who are residents of Tishomingo 12
- County, one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Governor, one 13
- 14 (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor and one
- (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of 15
- Tishomingo County; 16
- 17 Two (2) members who are residents of Alcorn County,
- one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor and 18
- one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of 19
- Alcorn County; 20
- (c) Two (2) members who are residents of Itawamba 21
- 22 County, one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Lieutenant
- Governor and one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Board of 23
- Supervisors of Itawamba County; and 24
- (d) Two (2) members who are residents of Prentiss 25
- County, one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Lieutenant 26
- 27 Governor and one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Board of
- 28 Supervisors of Prentiss County.

- 29 (2) Members of the Yellow Creek Regional Project Board shall
- 30 serve for a term concurrent with the term of the appointing
- 31 authority and until their successor is appointed. Any vacancy on
- 32 the board shall be filled by appointment of the original
- 33 appointing authority for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- 34 Members of the board shall receive no compensation for their
- 35 services, but shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary
- 36 expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, as provided
- 37 in Section 25-3-41 for state officers and employees. The board
- 38 shall operate under the rules and regulations of the authority and
- 39 shall meet at such times as determined by the authority. The
- 40 members of the board shall select a chairman and a vice chairman
- 41 from among their membership.
- 42 (3) Any proposal by the authority regarding the development,
- 43 operation and planning of the project described in Section
- 44 57-75-5(f)(vi) shall be presented to the Yellow Creek Regional
- 45 Project Board prior to its implementation. The authority shall
- 46 not implement any proposal regarding the development, operation
- 47 and planning of the project if such proposal is rejected by a vote
- 48 of two-thirds (2/3) of the membership of the Yellow Creek Regional
- 49 Project Board.
- 50 (4) The Yellow Creek Regional Project Board shall have the
- 51 authority to examine monthly expense reports regarding
- 52 expenditures made from the Yellow Creek Project Area Fund.
- 53 (5) This section shall stand repealed from and after June
- 54 30, <u>2003</u>.
- 55 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 56 and after its passage.
