- SECTION 1. Section 37-7-339, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9

- 37-7-339. (1) The school board of any local school 11
- district, in its discretion, may provide extended day and extended 12
- school year programs for kindergarten or compulsory-school-age 13
- students, or both, and may expend any funds for these purposes 14
- 15 which are available from * * * sources other than the adequate
- education program. It is not the intent of the Legislature, in 16
- enacting this section, to interfere with the Headstart program. 17
- School boards, in their discretion, may charge participants a 18
- reasonable fee for such programs. 19
- (2) 20 The school board of any school district may adopt any
- orders, policies, rules or regulations with respect to instruction 21
- within that school district for which no specific provision has 22
- 23 been made by general law and which are not inconsistent with the
- Mississippi Constitution of 1890, the Mississippi Code of 1972, or 24
- any order, policy, rule or regulation of the State Board of 25
