## HOUSE BILL NO. 501

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI FLAG TO BE DISPLAYED FROM SUNRISE TO 2
- 3 SUNSET FROM ALL PUBLIC BUILDINGS IN THIS STATE; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 3-3-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 3-3-15. The state flag shall be displayed from all public 8
- 9 buildings from sunrise to sunset; however, the state flag may be
- displayed from all public buildings twenty-four (24) hours a day 10
- if properly illuminated. The state flag should not be displayed 11
- when the weather is inclement, except when an all-weather flag is 12
- displayed. The state flag shall receive all of the respect and 13
- ceremonious etiquette given the American flag. \* \* \* However, 14
- nothing in this section shall be construed so as to affect the 15
- precedence given to the flag of the United States of America. 16
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2002. 18
