- or area of the motor vehicle that is not designed by the vehicle 12
- 13 manufacturer for the transportation of passengers.
- 14 Any person violating the provisions of subsection (1) of
- this section, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor and 15
- shall be punished as provided in Section 63-9-11. 16
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified in 17
- Chapter 3 of Title 63, Mississippi Code of 1972. 18
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19
- and after July 1, 2002. 20
