- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. (1) Any person, firm or corporation who
- dismantles, crushes or otherwise destroys motor vehicles shall 8
- 9 determine if any lien exists upon a motor vehicle and notify any
- lienholders by certified mail before dismantling, crushing or 10
- destroying such motor vehicle. A lienholder shall have seven (7) 11
- days after receipt of notice to claim a motor vehicle. A 12
- reasonable effort shall be made to identify and notify any 13
- 14 lienholder.
- Any person, firm or corporation who violates the 15
- provisions of subsection (1) of this section, upon conviction, 16
- shall be punished as follows: 17
- For a first offense by a fine of One Hundred 18
- 19 Dollars (\$100.00) per occurrence;
- For a second offense by a fine of Five Hundred 20
- 21 Dollars (\$500.00) per occurrence; and
- 22 (c) For a third or subsequent offense One Thousand
- 23 Dollars (\$1,000.00) per occurrence, the revocation of any business
- license for one (1) year and by imprisonment for not more than six 24
- (6) months. 25
- The State Tax Commission shall investigate and prosecute 26
- 27 violators of this section. The State Tax Commission may utilize
- the assistance of any law enforcement agency to carry out the 28

- 29 provisions of this section. The tax assessors of the counties
- 30 shall assist the State Tax Commission in performing its duties
- 31 under this section.
- 32 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 33 and after July 1, 2002.
