HOUSE BILL NO. 595

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 55-13-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM THE RESTRICTIONS ON THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT PERMITTED FOR BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES LOCATED ADJACENT TO THE NATCHEZ TRACE PARKWAY SHALL APPLY ONLY TO BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES CONSTRUCTED OR AUTHORIZED FOR CONSTRUCTION BEFORE JULY 1, 2002; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 55-13-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

10 55-13-35. (1) It shall be unlawful to construct or erect a building or other structure of more than three (3) stories or 11 thirty-five (35) feet in height, whichever is lesser, within one 12 thousand (1,000) feet of the outside boundary of the Natchez Trace 13 Parkway. Such restrictions on buildings and structures shall 14 apply notwithstanding that such area is located inside or outside 15 a municipality and notwithstanding any other provisions of law to 16 the contrary. It is the legislative intent of this section, in 17 part, that possession of a building permit on July 1, 1988, shall 18 not allow any construction after July 1, 1988, based on that 19 20 permit. This section shall not apply to any building in existence on July 1, 1988. 21

22 (2) Silos, buildings and structures designed for
23 agricultural use, churches and any building or structure
24 constructed or to be constructed on property that, on the
25 effective date of this act, is owned by a public school district
26 and used for educational purposes are exempted from the
27 application of this section. The exemptions provided in this
28 subsection (2) shall apply only to buildings and structures

29 constructed or authorized for construction by a building permit or

30 other appropriate permit issued before July 1, 2002.

31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after July 1, 2002.
