HOUSE BILL NO. 621

- AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION
- 2 27-19-56.32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE
- 3 OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES TO ACTIVE DUTY MEMBERS
- 4 OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED SERVICES; TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL
- 5 FEE FOR SUCH LICENSES; TO PROVIDE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF THE
- 6 ADDITIONAL FEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 9 27-19-56.32, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 10 <u>27-19-56.32.</u> In recognition of the patriotic services
- 11 rendered the United States, Mississippi and the citizens thereof,
- 12 any resident of the state who is on active duty with the Armed
- 13 Forces of the United States, upon payment of the road and bridge
- 14 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
- 15 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
- 16 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- 17 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
- 18 section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate
- 19 or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United
- 20 States Armed Forces. The distinctive license tags so issued shall
- 21 be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission may
- 22 prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both,
- 23 as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.
- 24 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
- 25 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
- 26 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the
- 27 distinctive license tag shall present proof of their active duty
- 28 membership in the United States Armed Services to the county tax
- 29 collector. The application and the additional fee imposed under

30 subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be

31 retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax

32 Commission within seven (7) days of the date the application is

33 made. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax

34 collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

35 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or

36 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license

tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount

38 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag

39 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all

40 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a

41 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established

42 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the

43 time the original application is made for a distinctive license

44 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of

45 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive

46 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive

license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax

49 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the

50 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,

51 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected

52 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute

53 such collections as follows:

54 (a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee

55 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this

56 section shall be deposited into a special fund that is created in

57 the State Treasury. Monies in the fund may be expended by the

58 Mississippi State Veterans Affairs Board for the maintenance,

59 operation and administration of state veterans homes.

60 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected

on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall

- 62 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
- 63 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
- 65 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 66 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
- 67 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
- 68 reconstruction of highways.
- 69 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 70 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 71 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 72 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 73 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 74 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 75 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 76 tag.
- 77 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 78 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 79 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 80 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 81 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 82 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 83 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 84 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 85 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 86 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 87 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 88 and after July 1, 2002.
