HOUSE BILL NO. 696

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE OUT-OF-DISTRICT COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR 1 COLLEGE STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN ATHLETIC AND OTHER 3 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AT THE COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE IN WHICH THEY ARE ENROLLED ON THE SAME BASIS AS STUDENTS WHO RESIDE 4
- WITHIN THAT COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT; TO AUTHORIZE 5
- COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES TO AWARD SCHOLARSHIPS TO 6 7 OUT-OF-DISTRICT STUDENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8
- SECTION 1. (1) Any community or junior college student who 9
- 10 is a resident of the State of Mississippi but not of the community
- or junior college district in which the student is enrolled must 11
- be allowed to participate in athletic programs and other 12
- extracurricular activities at the community or junior college in 13
- 14 which the student is enrolled on the same basis as students who
- 15 reside within that community or junior college district.
- A community or junior college district may award 16
- scholarships to students who are not residents of that community 17
- or junior college district on the same basis that scholarships are 18
- awarded to students who reside within that community or junior 19
- 20 college district.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 21
- 22 and after July 1, 2002.
