HOUSE BILL NO. 767

1 AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 91-9-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 ALLOW TRUSTS TO TAKE TITLE TO REAL PROPERTY; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
91-9-2, Mississippi Code of 1972:

91-9-2. (1) All property originally brought into the trust
or subsequently acquired by purchase or otherwise, on account of
the trust, is trust property.

10 (2) Unless the contrary intention appears, property acquired11 with trust funds is trust property.

Any estate in real property may be acquired in the trust 12 (3) 13 name. Title so acquired can be conveyed only in the trust name. A conveyance to a trust in the trust name, though 14 (4) 15 without words of inheritance, passes the entire estate of the grantor unless a contrary intent appears. This subsection (4) 16 shall apply to all conveyances to a trust in the trust name 17 18 heretofore made, provided, however, any person having a cause of action, because of such conveyance as of July 1, 2002, may 19 commence suit on such cause of action within one (1) year of said 20 21 date, unless such cause of action be sooner barred by existing law, and not afterwards. 22

23 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24 and after July 1, 2002.
