HOUSE BILL NO. 777

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 35-1-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD SHALL BE SOLELY 3 RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE STATE VETERANS HOMES LOCATED IN JACKSON, KOSCIUSKO AND OXFORD; TO PROHIBIT THE BOARD FROM CONTRACTING FOR MANAGEMENT PURPOSES WITH ANY NONGOVERNMENTAL ENTITY OR THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF 6 VETERANS AFFAIRS TO OPERATE ANY OF THE STATE VETERANS HOMES; TO 7 DIRECT THE BOARD TO FILE WITH CERTAIN LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES, ON 8 OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2004, A REPORT ON ITS RECOMMENDATIONS ON 9 WHETHER TO CONTINUE MANAGING THE JACKSON, KOSCIUSKO AND OXFORD 10 11 HOMES OR TO CONTRACT WITH A NONGOVERNMENTAL ENTITY TO OPERATE ANY OR ALL OF THE HOMES; TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF 12 HEALTH SHALL PERFORM AN INITIAL CERTIFICATION SURVEY OF THE STATE 13 VETERANS HOMES IN JACKSON, KOSCIUSKO AND OXFORD TO PROVIDE A BASELINE FOR MEASURING THE QUALITY OF CARE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 14 15 DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT PERIODIC FOLLOW-UP CERTIFICATION SURVEYS 16 OF THE STATE VETERANS HOMES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 17

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 19 **SECTION 1.** Section 35-1-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 20 amended as follows:
- 21 35-1-21. (1) Upon the establishment of the Mississippi
- 22 State Veterans Home, and any additional homes as may be
- 23 established, the Mississippi State Veterans Affairs Board is * * *
- 24 designated as the governing authority of any of those facilities.
- 25 The operation and maintenance of all veterans homes shall meet the
- 26 standards of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs with
- 27 regard to the operation of state veterans homes.
- 28 (2) The * * * board may contract with nongovernmental
- 29 entities or the United States Department of Veterans Affairs to
- 30 operate state veterans homes. The board may contract with the
- 31 vendor whose proposal is most advantageous to the state and
- 32 veterans, taking into consideration cost factors, program
- 33 suitability factors, management plan, delivery of care and service
- 34 to residents, excellence of program design, key personnel,

- 35 corporate or company resources, financial condition of the vendor,
- 36 corporate experience and past performance, and any other
- 37 requirements deemed necessary by the board and expressed in its
- 38 solicitation for proposals. Contract(s) awarded under this
- 39 subsection may be for periods exceeding one (1) year. The board
- 40 is not required to select the vendor offering the lowest cost
- 41 proposal but shall select the vendor who, in the board's
- 42 discretion, offers the proposal most advantageous to the State of
- 43 Mississippi and veterans. When any contract is awarded, the
- 44 reason(s) for the awarding of the contract shall be entered on the
- 45 minutes of the board. The provisions of this paragraph shall
- 46 supersede any rule or regulation of the State Personnel Board to
- 47 the contrary.
- 48 (3) The * * * board may, as permitted by federal laws or
- 49 regulations, purchase from the United States Department of
- 50 Veterans Affairs, from contracts established by the United States
- 51 Department of Veterans Affairs, or through other sharing
- 52 agreements between the board and the United States Department of
- 53 Veterans Affairs, services, commodities, supplies and equipment
- 54 for use in operation of, and provision of care to residents of,
- 55 the state veterans homes when those purchases or agreements are
- 56 advantageous to the veterans and the state.
- 57 (4) Beginning July 1, 2000, the * * * board shall be solely
- 58 responsible for the operation and maintenance of the State
- 59 Veterans Home located in Collins, Mississippi. Beginning July 1,
- 60 2002, the board shall be solely responsible for the operation and
- 61 maintenance of the state veterans homes located in Jackson,
- 62 Kosciusko and Oxford, Mississippi. The board shall not contract
- 63 for management purposes with any nongovernmental entity or the
- 04 United States Department of Veterans Affairs to operate any of the
- 65 state veterans homes. The * * * board shall hire the
- 66 administrators and all other personnel for the state veterans
- 67 homes. The mission of the * * * board in managing the Collins,

- 68 <u>Jackson, Kosciusko and Oxford,</u> Mississippi, <u>facilities</u> shall be to
- 69 provide domiciliary care and other related services for eligible
- 70 veterans in the most cost efficient manner. On or before January
- 71 1, 2002, the * * * board shall file a report with the Chairman of
- 72 the Senate Veterans and Military Affairs Committee and the
- 73 Chairman of the House Military Affairs Committee specifying its
- 74 recommendations on whether to continue to manage the Collins,
- 75 Mississippi, home or to contract with a nongovernmental entity to
- 76 operate the home. On or before January 1, 2004, the board shall
- 77 file a report with the Chairman of the Senate Veterans and
- 78 Military Affairs Committee and the Chairman of the House Military
- 79 Affairs Committee specifying its recommendations on whether to
- 80 continue managing the Jackson, Kosciusko and Oxford, Mississippi,
- 81 homes or to contract with a nongovernmental entity to operate any
- 82 or all of the homes. This subsection shall stand repealed from
- 83 and after July 1, 2004.
- 84 (5) The State Department of Health shall perform an initial
- 85 certification survey of the State Veterans Home in Collins,
- 86 Mississippi, on or about July 1, 2000. The State Department of
- 87 Health shall perform an initial certification survey of the state
- 88 veterans homes in Jackson, Kosciusko and Oxford, Mississippi, on
- 89 or about July 1, 2002. The purpose of these initial surveys is to
- 90 provide a baseline for measuring the quality of care during the
- 91 period for which this section applies. In addition to the initial
- 92 certification surveys, the State Department of Health shall, as
- 93 appropriate and in its discretion, conduct periodic follow-up
- 94 certification surveys, during the period for which this section
- 95 applies, of the state veterans homes in Collins, Jackson,
- 96 Kosciusko and Oxford, Mississippi.
- 97 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 98 and after July 1, 2002.
