COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

HOUSE BILL NO. 793

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE TWO CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN  
2 SIMPSON COUNTY AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER  
3 THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR  
4 CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following segments of highway are  
7 designated as state highways and placed under the jurisdiction of  
8 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and  
9 maintenance; and such highways, together with the highways  
10 designated in Section 65-3-3 and all other laws adding links to  
11 the designated state highway system are declared to be the state  
12 highway system of Mississippi:

13 Southern District - Simpson County:

14 Mississippi Highway 469 beginning at Harrisville near  
15 the old school building, Section 34, Township 2 North,  
16 Range 2 East, 7.2 miles north of its intersection with  
17 Mississippi Highway 28 at Union, thence .46 miles  
18 through Harrisville and ending at the beginning of state  
19 maintenance of Mississippi Highway 469 in Section 27,  
20 Township 2 North, Range 2 East.

21 Southern District - Simpson County:

22 Mississippi Highway 540 beginning at its intersection  
23 with Mississippi Highway 541 and extending easterly for  
24 a distance of 1077.75 feet.

25 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take  
26 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of  
27 the highway segments described under subsection (1) of this



28 section whenever such highway segments have been brought up to  
29 commission standards.

30         **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
31 and after July 1, 2002.
