HOUSE BILL NO. 797

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-59-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1
- REVISE THE PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE FOR 2
- RESIDENTIAL BUILDERS AND REMODELERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 73-59-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6

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- 73-59-3. (1) Except as otherwise provided in Section 7
- 73-59-15, persons who perform residential construction or 8
- residential improvement shall be licensed by the board annually, 9
- and, as a prerequisite to obtaining a license or renewal thereof, 10
- each shall submit to the board: 11
- Proof of workers' compensation insurance, if 12 (a)
- 13 applicable;
- A federal employment identification number or 14
- 15 social security number.
- The board shall not require liability insurance to be 16
- licensed under this chapter but if a licensee has liability 17
- insurance it shall be reflected on the certificate of licensure. 18
- The board shall issue or renew a license to a 19
- 20 residential builder or remodeler upon payment to the board of the
- 21 license fee. The initial license fee shall be Fifty Dollars
- 22 (\$50.00). The license fee may thereafter be increased or
- decreased by the board and cannot exceed One Hundred Dollars 23
- (\$100.00); however, the receipts from fees collected by the board 24
- shall be no greater than the amount required to pay all costs and 25
- 26 expenses incurred by the board in enforcing the provisions of this
- 27 chapter. All fees collected under this chapter shall be deposited

- 28 into the special fund in the State Treasury known as the "State
- 29 Board of Contractor's Fund" created pursuant to Section 31-3-17
- 30 and shall be used only for the administration and enforcement of
- 31 this chapter. Amounts in such fund shall not lapse into the State
- 32 General Fund at the end of a fiscal year. Interest accrued to
- 33 such fund shall remain in the fund. All expenditures from the
- 34 special fund shall be by requisition to the Department of Finance
- 35 and Administration, signed by the executive secretary of the board
- 36 and countersigned by the chairman or vice chairman of the board.
- 37 (4) The license shall expire on the last day of the twelfth
- 38 month following its issuance or renewal and shall become invalid
- 39 unless renewed. The board shall notify by mail every licensee
- 40 under this chapter of the date of the expiration of his license
- 41 and the amount of the fee required for renewal of the license for
- 42 one (1) year. Such notice shall be mailed within thirty (30) days
- 43 prior to the expiration date of the license. The failure on the
- 44 part of any licensee to renew his license annually in such twelfth
- 45 month shall not deprive such licensee of the right of renewal,
- 46 provided that renewal is effected within one hundred twenty (120)
- 47 days after the expiration date of the license by payment of the
- 48 license fee plus a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the license
- 49 fee. A new license required to replace a revoked, lost, mutilated
- or destroyed license may be issued, subject to the rules of the
- 51 board, for a charge of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).
- 52 (5) Any person who is not a resident of the State of
- 53 Mississippi who desires to perform residential construction or
- 54 residential improvement shall be licensed to perform such
- 55 construction or improvement as provided by this chapter.
- 56 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after July 1, 2002.
