HOUSE BILL NO. 816

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-41-211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO ALLOW BOARD CERTIFIED MUSIC THERAPISTS TO RECEIVE INSURANCE 3 REIMBURSEMENTS FOR THEIR SERVICES IF PRESCRIBED BY A PHYSICIAN OR 4 A PSYCHOLOGIST; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 83-41-211, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

83-41-211. Whenever any policy of insurance or any medical 8 9 service plan or hospital service contract or hospital and medical service contract issued in this state provides for reimbursement 10 for any diagnosis and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional 11 disorders only which are within the lawful scope of practice of a 12 duly licensed psychologist as defined in Section 73-31-3, within 13 the lawful scope of practice of a duly licensed professional 14 counselor as defined in Section 73-30-3, * * * within the lawful 15 scope of practice of a duly licensed clinical social worker as 16 defined in Section 73-53-3 or within the lawful scope of practice 17 of a board certified music therapist, the insured or other person 18 entitled to benefits under such policy shall be entitled to 19 reimbursement for such services, whether such services are 20 performed by a duly licensed physician, by a duly licensed 21 psychologist, by a duly licensed professional counselor, by a duly 22 licensed clinical social worker or by a board certified music 23 therapist if such treatment is prescribed by a physician or by a 24 psychologist, notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in any 25 26 statute or in such policy, plan or contract. Duly licensed psychologists shall be entitled to participate in such policies, 27 plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis and treatment of 28 H. B. No. 816 G1/2

mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as authorized by 29 Section 73-31-3. A duly licensed professional counselor shall be 30 entitled to participate in such policies, plans or contracts 31 providing for the diagnosis and treatment of mental, nervous or 32 33 emotional disorders only as authorized by Section 73-30-3. A duly licensed clinical social worker shall be entitled to participate 34 in such policies, plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis 35 and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as 36 authorized by Section 73-53-3. A board certified music therapist 37 shall be entitled to participate in such policies, plans or 38 contracts only if his or her services are prescribed by a 39 40 physician or a psychologist. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41

42 and after July 1, 2002.
