## HOUSE BILL NO. 826

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF OLD U.S. HIGHWAY 49 1 IN RANKIN COUNTY AS A STATE HIGHWAY AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENT 2 UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION 3 4 COMMISSION FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following segment of highway is designated as a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of 8 9 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways 10 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to 11 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state 12 highway system of Mississippi: 13 14 Central District - Rankin County: A three-mile section of Old U.S. 49 beginning at U.S. 80 15 and extending southerly to new U.S. 49 in the City of 16 Richland. 17 The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall (2) 18 19 take over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of the segment of highway described under 20 subsection (1) of this section whenever the commission 21 22 certifies that such segment of highway has been brought up to commission standards and all utilities, signs, structures and 23 other encroachments on such highway and right-of-way, are 24 removed or relocated. 25

26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 27 and after its passage.
