HOUSE BILL NO. 829

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 1 27-19-56.32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE 2 3 OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO SUPPORTERS OF MISSISSIPPI 4 AGRICULTURE; TO PRESCRIBE AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SUCH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF SUCH FEES; AND 5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 8 27-19-56.32, Mississippi Code of 1972: 9

10 27-19-56.32. Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating 11 to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment 12 of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and 13 registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 14 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 15 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount of 16 Thirty Dollars (\$30.00), shall be privileged to obtain one 17 distinctive motor vehicle license plate or tag for each motor 18 vehicle registered in his name identifying him as a supporter of 19 Mississippi agriculture. 20

(2) The tags shall depict the image of a cotton boll, shall 21 be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission shall 22 prescribe, subject to the approval of the Mississippi License Tag 23 Commission, and shall consist of such letters or numbers or both 24 as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 25

Application for the distinctive license tags shall be 26 (3) 27 made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee, less Two 28 Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be

30 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
31 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee
32 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county
33 general fund.

34 (4) The distinctive license tag shall be issued for a
35 one-year period. The additional annual fee shall be due and
36 payable at the time of renewal registration.

37 (5) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 38 State Treasury on the day received. At the end of each month, the 39 State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected under 40 this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute such 41 collections as follows:

(a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued under this section
shall be deposited into a special fund that is created in the
State Treasury to be known as the "Agriculture Distinctive License
Tag Fund." Monies in the fund may be expended, upon legislative
appropriation, by the Mississippi Department of Agriculture to
help defray the operating expenses of the department.

(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

53 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
54 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
55 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
56 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
57 reconstruction of highways.

(6) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) month

and year license decals for each distinctive license tag issued
under this section, which will expire the same month and year as
the regular license tag.

66 (7) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 67 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 68 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 69 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 70 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 71 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 72 73 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 74 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 75

76 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 77 and after July 1, 2002.
