HOUSE BILL NO. 834

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF HIGHWAY IN COAHOMA  
2 COUNTY AS A STATE HIGHWAY AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENT UNDER THE  
3 JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR  
4 MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following highway is designated as a  
7 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi  
8 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the  
9 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding  
10 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be  
11 the state highway system of Mississippi:

12 Northern District - Coahoma County:

13 That segment of highway beginning Six-tenths (.6) of a  
14 mile east of the termination of state maintenance of  
15 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to  
16 the intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway 61,  
17 and that segment of highway extending westerly from the  
18 intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway 61 to  
19 its intersection with the eastern city limits of Friars  
20 Point, Mississippi.

21 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take  
22 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of  
23 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this  
24 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of  
25 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all  
26 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such  
27 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.



28           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
29 and after July 1, 2002.
