HOUSE BILL NO. 855

AN ACT TO CREATE THE FAIRNESS IN LITIGATION ACT; TO PROVIDE
THAT THE SAME RULES WOULD APPLY TO A LEGAL CLAIM BY AN INJURED
PERSON WILL APPLY TO THE GOVERNMENT WHEN IT SEEKS TO RECOVER FOR A

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> This act shall be known and may be cited as the 7 "Fairness in Litigation Act."
- 8 **SECTION 2.** In any action brought by the state, or any
- 9 political subdivision thereof which accepts state funds, that
- 10 seeks to recover directly from any defendant, to the extent
- 11 permitted by applicable law, any benefits or services it has
- 12 provided or paid for or is obligated directly or indirectly to
- 13 provide or pay for on behalf of another person, the claimant shall
- 14 be subject tot he same procedural rules and substantive law,
- 15 including notification requirements, limitations, and affirmative
- 16 defenses that would apply to a claim brought against such
- 17 defendant by the person on whose behalf the benefits or services
- 18 were provided or paid or are obligated to be provided or paid.
- 19 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2002.
