HOUSE BILL NO. 865

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT REQUIRED TO BE CONTRIBUTED BY A COUNTY THAT
- 3 DESIRES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BEAVER CONTROL AND ERADICATION
- 4 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 49-7-201. (1) There is hereby established a beaver control
- 9 program which shall be developed by the Beaver Control Advisory
- 10 Board created in Section 49-7-203 and administered by the
- 11 Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks with the
- 12 advice of the board or administered by a federal agency pursuant
- 13 to an agreement with the commission for such purpose. The program
- 14 shall be limited to the control or eradication of beavers only on
- 15 private lands or public lands, excluding federally owned lands but
- 16 including lands whereupon easements are granted to a federal
- 17 entity. The commission may employ such personnel as is necessary
- 18 to implement its duties to administer the program and set the
- 19 salary of such personnel subject to State Personnel Board
- 20 quidelines.
- 21 (2) Any state, local or private funds available to the
- 22 commission to fund the program shall be used to match federal
- 23 funds available for such purpose. The commission may execute such
- 24 agreements with any agency of the federal government as are
- 25 necessary to obtain federal matching funds to finance the beaver
- 26 control program.
- 27 (3) Nonfederal funds to help finance the program may be
- 28 obtained by the commission from the following sources:

29 (a)	Appropriations	b	v the	Legislature:

- 30 (b) Contributions from participating counties;
- 31 (c) Charges on participating landowners; and/or
- 32 (d) Contributions from any other sources for such
- 33 purpose.
- 34 (4) (a) Any county in the state desiring to participate in
- 35 the program during its fiscal year shall contribute Four Thousand
- 36 Dollars (\$4,000.00) for such purpose from any funds available in
- 37 its general fund. Such county shall commit such funds to the
- 38 program for the ensuing fiscal year by adopting and submitting a
- 39 resolution to that effect on or before August 1 to the commission.
- 40 The commission shall establish the due date for the payment of
- 41 contributions by counties.
- 42 (b) The sum of county contributions may be matched by
- 43 nonfederal funds available to the state for the beaver control
- 44 program.
- 45 (5) Participating landowner means any person, corporation or
- 46 association owning land in this state and taking part in the
- 47 beaver control program.
- 48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after July 1, 2002.
