HOUSE BILL NO. 890

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 69-3-109, 69-3-111 AND 69-3-113, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE SEED CERTIFICATION LAW TO INCLUDE OTHER FARM PRODUCTS THAT MAY BE DEFINED BY REGULATIONS; 1 2 3 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5

SECTION 1. Section 69-3-109, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:

69-3-109. Every person, firm, association or corporation who 8

9 shall issue, use or circulate any certificate, advertisement, tag,

10 seal, poster, letterhead, marking circular, written or printed

representation, or description of or pertaining to seeds, plants 11

or plant parts or other farm products that may be defined by 12

regulations intended for propagation or sale or sold or offered 13

for sale wherein the words "Mississippi Certified," or 14

"Mississippi State Certified," "State Certified," or similar words 15

or phrases are used or employed, or wherein are used or employed 16

signs, symbols, maps, diagrams, pictures, words or phrases 17

expressly or impliedly stating or representing that such seeds, 18

plants or plant parts or other farm products comply with or 19

conform to the certification standards or requirements as made by 20

the approved state seed certifying agency of Mississippi, shall be 21

subject to the provisions of this article, provided that this 22

article shall not apply to the certification of plants or plant 23

products for freedom from disease or insects which is now 24

conducted under the authority of the Commissioner of Agriculture 25

26 and Commerce. Every issuance, use, or circulation of any

certificate or any other instrument as in this section above 27

- 28 described shall be deemed to be "certification" as this term is
- 29 employed in this article.
- 30 SECTION 2. Section 69-3-111, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 31 amended as follows:
- 32 69-3-111. The state seed certifying agency shall not have
- 33 the power to engage in the sale or processing of seeds, plants or
- 34 plant parts or other farm products or to designate any agency or
- 35 individual for these purposes except that the state seed
- 36 certifying agency may promote the sale of certified seeds in
- 37 general through advertising.
- 38 SECTION 3. Section 69-3-113, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 39 amended as follows:
- 40 69-3-113. The duly approved state seed certifying agency is
- 41 hereby vested with the full authority to establish, create and
- 42 specify rules and regulations for the designation of seeds, plants
- 43 and plant parts and other farm products as certified or
- 44 Mississippi certified to be grown, harvested, offered for sale or
- 45 distributed. Such rules and regulations shall be approved by the
- 46 state seed board before becoming effective. No seeds, plants or
- 47 plant parts or other farm products grown or to be grown in
- 48 Mississippi shall be eligible for certification hereunder except
- 49 by full compliance as to standards, requirements and forms of or
- 50 for certification as may be made by the duly approved state seed
- 51 certifying agency. No certification within the provisions of this
- 52 article shall be made or authorized except through the approved
- 53 state certifying agency as herein provided.
- 54 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 55 and after July 1, 2002.
