## HOUSE BILL NO. 951

AN ACT CREATING A NEW SECTION 3-3-43, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1 1972, DESIGNATING THE TEDDY BEAR AS THE STATE TOY; AND FOR RELATED 2 3 PURPOSES. WHEREAS, the Teddy Bear has remained one of America's 4 all-time favorite toys for nearly a century; and 5 WHEREAS, the origin of the Teddy Bear dates back to a hunting 6 trip in Smedes, Mississippi, on November 14, 1902; and 7 8 WHEREAS, during that particular hunting expedition, President Theodore Roosevelt refused to shoot a small, exhausted black bear; 9 10 and WHEREAS, the shot not fired at the cuddly creature in the 11 12 Mississippi Delta was soon heard around the land as a great credit 13 to the heroic and sportsmanlike conduct of President Roosevelt; 14 and WHEREAS, because of this journey by the President to 15 Mississippi, the stuffed bear toy, appropriately named the "Teddy 16 Bear, " evolved and continues to be a universal symbol of love, 17 18 comfort and joy for children of all ages; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 19 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 20 21 3-3-43, Mississippi Code of 1972: 3-3-43. The Teddy Bear is designated the state toy of 22 23 Mississippi. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24 and after July 1, 2002.
