HOUSE BILL NO. 1016

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SECTION OF HIGHWAY IN WEBSTER
2 AND CHOCTAW COUNTIES AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO
3 PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION
4 COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
7 state highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the
8 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
9 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
10 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
11 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
12 highway system of Mississippi.

13 Northern District - Webster and Choctaw Counties:

14 A highway segment beginning at the intersection of
15 Mississippi Highway 9 and the Natchez Trace Parkway and
16 extending in a northwesterly direction to U.S. Highway 82
17 at or near Tomnolen.

18 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
19 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
20 highway segment designated under subsection (2) of this section
21 whenever the commission certifies that such segment of highway has
22 been brought up to commission standards and all utilities, signs,
23 structures and other encroachments on such highway and
24 right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after July 1, 2002.
