HOUSE BILL NO. 1030 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-15-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO CLARIFY THAT SCHOOL DISTRICTS MAY REQUIRE A PARENT, LEGAL 2 GUARDIAN OR LEGAL CUSTODIAN TO ACCOMPANY A CHILD SEEKING TO ENROLL 3 4 IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-15-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 37-15-11. Whenever any minor child seeks or applies to 8 9 enroll or gain entrance to any public school in this state, and the child is not accompanied by an adult or is accompanied by an 10 adult who is not the child's parent, * * * guardian, if a legal 11 guardian has been appointed for the child, or legal custodian, the 12 school official or officials or teacher to whom the child applies 13 or reports for enrollment or admission may delay consideration of 14 the enrollment or enlistment of the minor child and require the 15 child's parent, legal guardian or legal custodian to accompany the 16 child and apply for * * * enrollment and admission into the school 17 for and on behalf of the minor child. 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19

20 and after July 1, 2002.
