HOUSE BILL NO. 1058

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-42, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXPAND THE AUTHORITY OF COUNTY BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO PERFORM CERTAIN WORK AND MAKE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF PUBLIC SCHOOL GROUNDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 19-3-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 19-3-42. (1) The board of supervisors of any county is
- 9 hereby authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to grade,
- 10 gravel or shell, repair, and/or maintain private gravel or shell
- 11 roads or driveways to private residences if such roads or
- 12 driveways are used for school bus turnarounds.
- 13 (2) Prior to engaging in the work authorized in subsection
- 14 (1) of this section, the board of supervisors shall spread upon
- 15 the official minutes of the board:
- 16 (a) The written request of the school board for such
- 17 work;
- 18 (b) The written approval of the board of supervisors
- 19 for such work;
- 20 (c) The specific location of the road or driveway to be
- 21 worked; and
- 22 (d) The name of the owner of the road or driveway to be
- 23 worked.
- 24 (3) The written request of the school board, as required in
- 25 subsection (2)(a) above, shall contain a current list of all
- 26 active school bus turnarounds presently in use by the school
- 27 district or contemplated for use by the school district for the
- 28 present school year. The approval by the board of supervisors

- 29 shall be valid and effective for the period of time that a
- 30 turnaround is anticipated for use, but in no event for a period
- 31 greater than one (1) year.
- 32 (4) In addition to the authority granted in subsection (1)
- 33 of this section * * *, the board of supervisors of any county is
- 34 further authorized, in its discretion, to:
- 35 (a) Maintain public school grounds of the county, which
- 36 shall include the authority to:
- (i) Construct new buildings or structures;
- 38 <u>(ii) Improve, repair or demolish existing</u>
- 39 buildings or structures;
- 40 (iii) Erect and install athletic and recreational
- 41 equipment;
- 42 (iv) Clean, remove debris, and provide landscape
- 43 services to the land and buildings;
- (v) Expend from any available monies of the county
- 45 such amount as the board of supervisors deems necessary or
- desirable to perform the work and services described in items (i)
- 47 through (iv) of this paragraph; and
- 48 (b) Grade, gravel, shell or overlay, and/or * * *
- 49 maintain gravel, shell, asphalt or concrete roads, driveways or
- 50 parking lots of public schools of the county.
- Before engaging in such work or services or expending any
- 52 monies for such purposes, the board of supervisors shall spread
- 53 upon its official minutes the written request of the school board
- 54 for such work, services or expenditure, the written approval of
- 55 the board of supervisors for such work, services or expenditure
- 56 and the specific location of the school grounds or road, driveway
- 57 or parking lot * * *.
- 58 (5) In addition to any other authority granted in this
- 59 section, the board of supervisors of any county is hereby
- 60 authorized, in its discretion, to repair and maintain driveways
- 61 and parking lots of: (a) any nonprofit organization in the county

- 62 which is tax exempt under Section 501(c) of the United States
- 63 Internal Revenue Code and which has as one (1) of its primary
- 64 purposes for organization to aid and assist in the rehabilitation
- of persons suffering from drug abuse or drug addiction; and (b)
- 66 any private, nonprofit cemeteries in the county. The board of
- 67 supervisors of any county shall not be authorized under the
- 68 provisions of this subsection to repair or maintain driveways or
- 69 parking lots located more than one hundred fifty (150) feet from
- 70 the center of any highway, road or street under the jurisdiction
- 71 of the county.
- 72 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 73 and after October 1, 2002.
