- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 49-15-305, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 49-15-305. (1) The commission shall submit three (3) 8
- 9 nominees for the position of executive director to the Governor.
- 10 The Governor shall appoint the executive director from the list of
- nominees with the advice and consent of the Senate. The 11
- commission may remove the executive director from office for good 12
- cause. The executive director shall be knowledgeable and 13
- experienced in marine resources management. 14
- The executive director of the department shall have the 15
- 16 following powers and duties:
- 17 (a) To supervise and direct all administrative,
- inspection and technical activities and personnel of the 18
- department; 19
- To employ qualified professional personnel in the 20
- subject matter or fields, and any other technical and clerical 21
- staff as may be required for the operation of the department; 22
- To coordinate all studies in the State of 23

- Mississippi concerned with the supply, development, use and 24
- conservation of marine resources; 25
- (d) To prepare and deliver to the Legislature and the 26
- Governor on or before January 1 of each year, and at any other 27
- times as may be required by the Legislature or Governor, a full 28

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- 30 statement of expenditures of the department and any
- 31 recommendations the department may have;
- 32 (e) To enter into cooperative agreements with any
- 33 federal or state agency or subdivision thereof, or any public or
- 34 private institution located inside or outside the State of
- 35 Mississippi, or any person, corporation or association in
- 36 connection with studies and investigations pertaining to marine
- 37 resources, provided the agreements do not have a financial cost in
- 38 excess of the amounts appropriated for the purposes by the
- 39 Legislature and to expend discretionary funds to develop such
- 40 agreements, studies and investigations; and
- 41 (f) To carry out all regulations and rules adopted by
- 42 the commission and enforce all licenses and permits issued by the
- 43 department.
- 44 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after July 1, 2002.
