HOUSE BILL NO. 1083

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-84, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- TO CLARIFY REGULATION OF CRAB TRAPS AND FEMALE CRABS BEARING EGGS;
- TO REPEAL SECTION 49-15-85, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH RELATES TO THE PROTECTION OF EGG-BEARING FEMALE CRABS AND 3
- 4
- DUPLICATES PROVISIONS OF SECTION 49-15-84; AND FOR RELATED 5
- 6 PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 49-15-84, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8
- amended as follows: 9
- 49-15-84. (1) The commission shall coordinate with the Gulf 10
- Coast Research Laboratory in the development of an ordinance for 11
- the purpose of taking Callinectes sapidus (blue crab) or allied 12
- species. The ordinance shall include provisions for the 13
- establishment of size limits for individual or market use as well 14
- as establishing legal harvest size for the cultivating of peeler 15
- crabs and soft-shell crabs. 16
- (2) The commission shall establish * * * specifications for 17
- crab traps and shall require buoys of adequate size which are 18
- identified as to the owner of the buoys and traps. * * * 19
- Recreational crabbers may use no more than six (6) crab traps per 20
- household. The taking of crabs with drop nets is permitted 21
- without a license. 22
- (a) It is unlawful to catch, hold or have in possession 23
- any female sponge crab or any female crab bearing visible eggs at 24
- any time within marine waters. It is not unlawful to catch those 25
- crabs unintentionally, if the crabs are immediately returned to 26
- 27 the water.
- (b) This subsection shall not apply to the importation 2.8
- of female crabs, if the shipment of imported female sponge crabs 29

- 30 has with it an invoice from a licensed harvester from a state that
- 31 allows the taking of such crabs or a certificate from the
- 32 appropriate agency verifying that the crabs were taken legally.
- 33 SECTION 2. Section 49-15-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
- 34 relates to the protection of egg-bearing female crabs and
- 35 duplicates provisions found in Section 1 of this act, is repealed.
- 36 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 2002.
