HOUSE BILL NO. 1086

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES TO SELL LICENSES 2 3 BY ELECTRONIC MEANS; TO PROVIDE A FEE FOR A REPLACEMENT LICENSE; 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 49-15-29. (1) The commission shall assess and collect, 8 9 license fees and taxes as authorized under this chapter. (2) All commercial licenses provided for under this chapter 10 that relate to seafood shall be purchased from May 1 through April 11 30 at the fees provided in this chapter. The licenses shall 12 expire on April 30 following the date of issuance. If a 13 commercial license is lost or destroyed, a licensee shall obtain a 14 replacement license for a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00). The 15 16 license shall be clearly marked as a replacement license. When an application for an original or renewal license 17 (3) of any kind authorized by this chapter is received by the 18 commission, the commission shall determine whether the vessel or 19 related equipment subject to that license is owned and operated in 20 compliance with applicable federal and state laws. If the 21 commission determines that a vessel or its owner is not in 22 compliance with applicable federal and state laws, then no license 23 shall be issued or renewed for the operation of that vessel for a 24 period of one (1) year. All licenses shall be made available for 25 purchase at any building which is regularly operated by the 26 department or commission on the Mississippi Gulf Coast. 27

The commission may authorize any person, other than a (4) 28 salaried employee of the state to issue any license under this 29 chapter which the commission deems appropriate. 30 The authorized person may collect and retain for issuance of the license the sum 31 32 of One Dollar (\$1.00) in addition to the license fee provided in 33 this chapter. The commission shall establish the qualifications of persons authorized to issue licenses under this section and 34 shall also establish the procedure for the issuance of that 35 license by the authorized person and the procedure for collection 36 of license fees by and from the authorized person. 37

(5) The commission may design, establish and administer a
program to provide for the purchase, by electronic means, of any
license permit, registration or reservation issued by the
commission or department. Any actual costs associated with making
licenses available by electronic means may be added to the cost of
the electronic licensing program.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
