HOUSE BILL NO. 1136

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REQUIRE STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING AND COMMUNITY AND 2 JUNIOR COLLEGES TO WAIVE OUT-OF-STATE TUITION FOR NONRESIDENTS WHO WERE BORN IN MISSISSIPPI AND ARE VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES 3 4 ARMED FORCES; TO AMEND SECTIONS 37-29-81, 37-29-423 AND 37-103-5, 5 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS 6 ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-103-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 10 amended as follows: 37-103-25. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions 11 of Higher Learning and the boards of trustees of the community 12 colleges and junior colleges are *** * *** authorized to prescribe the 13 amount of tuition and fees to be paid by students attending the 14 15 several state-supported institutions of higher learning and community colleges and junior colleges of the State of 16 Mississippi. * * * 17 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the 18 total tuition to be paid by residents of other states shall not be 19 20 less than the average cost per student from appropriated funds. However, the tuition to be paid by a resident of another state 21 shall be equal to the tuition amount established under subsection 22 23 (1) of this section if: 24 (a) The nonresident student was born in the State of Mississippi but subsequently relocated and resided outside the 25 state as a minor under the care of the minor's father or mother, 26 27 or both;

(b) The nonresident student is a veteran who served in
the Armed Forces of the United States; and

(c) The nonresident student is domiciled in Mississippi 30 no later than six (6) months after the nonresident student's 31 separation from service, as evidenced by a Report of Separation 32 from Military Service or other military discharge document, for 33 34 the purpose of enrolling in a state institution of higher learning or a community or junior college. 35 SECTION 2. Section 37-29-81, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 36 amended as follows: 37 37-29-81. The district, in the discretion of the board of 38 39 trustees, may charge fees and tuitions in accordance with Section 40 37-103-25. SECTION 3. Section 37-29-423, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 41 amended as follows: 42 The Mississippi Gulf Coast Junior College 37-29-423. 43 District, in the discretion of the board of trustees, may charge 44 fees and tuitions in accordance with Section 37-103-25. 45 46 SECTION 4. Section 37-103-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 47 amended as follows: 37-103-5. A person who has entered the State of Mississippi 48 49 from another state and enters an educational institution is considered a nonresident. Even though he may have been legally 50 51 adopted by a resident of Mississippi, or may have been a qualified voter, or a landowner, or may otherwise have sought to establish 52 legal residence, except as otherwise provided in Section 53 37-103-25(2), such a person will still be considered as being a 54 nonresident of Mississippi if he has entered this state for the 55 56 purpose of enrolling in an educational institution. SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 57 and after July 1, 2002.
