## HOUSE BILL NO. 1151

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-21-111, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1
- TO REQUIRE THE COMMISSION ON WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO SHARE A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF FEDERAL OR NONSTATE FUNDS FOR BOAT 2

- AND WATER SAFETY WITH THE COMMISSION ON MARINE RESOURCES; AND FOR 4
- 5 RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 59-21-111, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, 9 59-21-111. (1)
- Fisheries and Parks shall be the Mississippi Boat and Water Safety 10
- Commission, and shall exercise the duties and responsibilities of 11
- the Mississippi Boat and Water Safety Commission through the 12
- Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, insofar 13
- 14 as practicable under the provisions of Chapter 4 of Title 49,
- Mississippi Code of 1972; except on marine waters under the 15
- jurisdiction of the Commission on Marine Resources. 16
- The Commission on Marine Resources shall exercise the 17
- duties and responsibilities of the Mississippi Boat and Water 18
- 19 Safety Commission through the Mississippi Department of Marine
- Resources on the marine waters of the state. The Commission on 20
- Marine Resources shall not exercise any powers related to 21
- 22 numbering of undocumented vessels. Those powers are vested
- 23 exclusively in the Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks.
- The Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and the 24
- Commission on Marine Resources shall enter into a memorandum of 25
- agreement to share in the use of any federal or other nonstate 26
- 27 funds awarded for boat and water safety and the funds shall be
- timely distributed. The memorandum shall provide that the 28

- 29 Department of Marine Resources, on behalf of the Commission on
- 30 Marine Resources, shall be awarded at least twenty-five percent
- 31 (25%) of the total amount of such funds for use on boat and water
- 32 <u>safety related programs.</u>
- 33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2002.
