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HOUSE BILL NO. 1213 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1, 3 AND 7 OF CHAPTER 112, LAWS OF 1 2001, TO TRANSFER FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2002 APPROPRIATION TO 2 THE MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AMONG VARIOUS 3 4 CATEGORIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 112, Laws of 2001, is amended 6 as follows: 7 Section 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 9 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 10 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management 11 Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et 12 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 13 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 817,910.00. 14 SECTION 2. Section 3, Chapter 112, Laws of 2001, is amended 15 16 as follows: 17 Section 3. 41 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 42 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 43 Services" for fiscal year 2003 do not exceed fiscal year 2002 44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 45 46 are added to the agency's fiscal year 2003 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 47 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 49 50 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 51 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 52 53 cost and/or the fiscal year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 54 55 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 56 annual cost or the fiscal year 2002 "Personal Services" 57 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 58 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 59 60 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 61

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No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

68 **SECTION 3.** Section 7, Chapter 112, Laws of 2001, is amended 69 as follows:

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be Section 7. 70 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 71 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 72 Management Agency to be used to establish a special reserve fund 73 in the State Treasury for Disaster Relief, for the fiscal year 74 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 75 0.00. SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 77 and after its passage.
