- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Every insurer that writes medical malpractice
- 8 insurance in this state shall file in the Office of the
- 9 Commissioner of Insurance, on or before the first day of March of
- 10 each year the following:
- 11 (a) A disclosure statement showing all medical
- 12 malpractice claims made and paid for by the insurer for the
- 13 preceding year on policies covering medical doctors, medical
- 14 personnel and nursing homes; and
- 15 (b) A financial statement, completed in accordance with
- 16 generally accepted accounting principles, depicting the income and
- 17 expenses derived from medical malpractice insurance policies
- 18 written in the State of Mississippi only.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2002.
