- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Every private employer in the State of
- 6 Mississippi shall grant any of his employees who are the victims
- 7 of a violent crime a leave period of up to thirty (30) days of
- 8 time, with or without pay. The employer shall grant those
- 9 employees their same jobs with the same pay upon their return to
- 10 work if they return no later than thirty (30) days after the
