## HOUSE BILL NO. 1224

AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 11-11-8, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE FOR VENUE IN MEDICAL MALPRACTICE ACTIONS; TO AMEND 2 3 SECTION 11-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5

SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 6 11-11-8, Mississippi Code of 1972: 7

11-11-8. Notwithstanding any other venue statute or law that 8 9 may otherwise apply, except as provided in Section 11-46-13, any malpractice action for damages for injury or wrongful death 10 against any health care provider as that term is defined in 11 Section 11-1-59, even when such malpractice action is joined with 12 other causes of action and/or includes one or more nonhealth care 13 provider defendants, shall be brought in the county in which the 14 alleged negligent act or omission regarding the malpractice of the 15 health care provider occurred. 16

SECTION 2. Section 11-11-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 17 amended as follows: 18

11-11-3. Except as provided in Section 11-11-8, civil 19 actions of which the circuit court has original jurisdiction shall 20 be commenced in the county in which the defendant or any of them 21 may be found or in the county where the cause of action may occur 22 or accrue and, if the defendant is a domestic corporation, in the 23 county in which said corporation is domiciled or in the county 24 where the cause of action may occur or accrue, except where 25 26 otherwise provided, and except actions of trespass on land, ejectment and actions for the statutory penalty for cutting and 27 28 boxing trees and firing woods and actions for the actual value of H. trees cut which shall be brought in the county where the land or some part thereof is situated. If a civil action is brought in an improper county, such action may be transferred to the proper county pursuant to Section 11-11-17.

33 **SECTION 3**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2002.
