HOUSE BILL NO. 1226

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 31-3-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE NEW COMMERCIAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS IN THE
- 3 DEFINITION OF CONTRACTOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 31-3-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 31-3-1. The following words, as used in this chapter, shall
- 8 have the meanings specified below:
- 9 "Board": The State Board of Contractors created under this
- 10 chapter.
- "Contractor": Any person contracting or undertaking as prime
- 12 contractor, subcontractor or sub-subcontractor of any tier to do
- 13 any erection, building, construction, reconstruction, repair,
- 14 maintenance or related work on any public or private project;
- 15 however, "contractor" shall not include any owner of a dwelling or
- 16 other structure to be constructed, altered, repaired or improved
- 17 and not for sale, lease, public use or assembly. It is further
- 18 provided that nothing herein shall apply to:
- 19 (a) Any contract or undertaking on a public project by
- 20 a prime contractor, subcontractor or sub-subcontractor of any tier
- 21 involving erection, building, construction, reconstruction,
- 22 repair, maintenance or related work where such contract,
- 23 subcontract or undertaking is less than Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 24 (\$50,000.00);
- 25 (b) Any contract or undertaking on a private project by
- 26 a prime contractor, subcontractor or sub-subcontractor of any tier
- 27 involving erection, building, construction, reconstruction,

- 28 repair, maintenance or related work where such contract,
- 29 subcontract or undertaking is less than One Hundred Thousand
- 30 Dollars (\$100,000.00);
- 31 (c) Highway construction, highway bridges, overpasses
- 32 and any other project incidental to the construction of highways
- 33 which are designated as federal aid projects and in which federal
- 34 funds are involved;
- 35 (d) A residential project to be occupied by fifty (50)
- 36 or fewer families and not more than three (3) stories in height;
- 37 (e) A residential subdivision where the contractor is
- 38 developing either single-family or multi-family lots;
- 39 (f) A new commercial construction project not exceeding
- 40 five thousand (5,000) square feet and not more than two (2)
- 41 stories in height;
- 42 (g) Erection of a microwave tower built for the purpose
- 43 of telecommunication transmissions;
- (h) Any contract or undertaking on a public project by
- 45 a prime contractor, subcontractor or sub-subcontractor of any tier
- 46 involving the construction, reconstruction, repair or maintenance
- 47 of fire protection systems where such contract, subcontract or
- 48 undertaking is less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00);
- 49 (i) Any contract or undertaking on a private project by
- 50 a prime contractor, subcontractor or sub-subcontractor of any tier
- 51 involving the construction, reconstruction, repair or maintenance
- 52 of fire protection systems where such contract, subcontract or
- 53 undertaking is less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); or
- 54 (j) Any contract or undertaking on a private or public
- 55 project by a prime contractor, subcontractor or sub-subcontractor
- of any tier involving the construction, reconstruction, repair or
- 57 maintenance of technically specialized installations if performed
- 58 by a Mississippi contractor who has been in the business of
- 59 installing fire protection sprinkler systems on or before July 1,
- 60 2000.

- "Certificate of responsibility": A certificate numbered and
- 62 held by a contractor issued by the board under the provisions of
- 63 this chapter after payment of the special privilege license tax
- 64 therefor levied under this chapter.
- "Person": Any person, firm, corporation, joint venture or
- 66 partnership, association or other type of business entity.
- "Private project": Any project for erection, building,
- 68 construction, reconstruction, repair, maintenance or related work
- 69 which is not funded in whole or in part with public funds.
- 70 "Public agency": Any board, commission, council or agency of
- 71 the State of Mississippi or any district, county or municipality
- 72 thereof, including school, hospital, airport and all other types
- 73 of governing agencies created by or operating under the laws of
- 74 this state.
- 75 "Public funds": Monies of public agencies, whether obtained
- 76 from taxation, donation or otherwise; or monies being expended by
- 77 public agencies for the purposes for which such public agencies
- 78 exist.
- 79 "Public project": Any project for erection, building,
- 80 construction, reconstruction, repair, maintenance or related work
- 81 which is funded in whole or in part with public funds.
- 82 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 83 and after July 1, 2002.
