## HOUSE BILL NO. 1230

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 77-9-119, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE RAILROAD COMPANIES ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS 3 STATE TO MERGE WITH OTHER RAILROAD COMPANIES; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 77-9-119, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

77-9-119. Any railroad company organized and existing under 8 9 the laws of this state and which is subject to the Interstate Commerce Commission Termination Act of 1995 shall have power to 10 consolidate with any other railroad company, organized under the 11 laws of this or any other state, and shall have power to purchase 12 or lease the railroad, franchises, and properties of any other 13 railroad company organized under the laws of this state, and to 14 purchase and hold the capital stock or a part thereof of any other 15 railroad company organized under the laws of this or any other 16 state, wherever any such action has first been permitted by an act 17 or acts of Congress and an order or orders of the Interstate 18 Commerce Commission of the United States and of the Mississippi 19 Public Service Commission. In the event of consolidation, the 20 consolidated company shall become thereby a domestic corporation 21 of the State of Mississippi. 22

Any railroad company organized and existing under the laws of this state and which is subject to the Interstate Commerce Commission Termination Act of 1995 shall have the power to merge with any other railroad company organized under the laws of this or any other state pursuant to the Mississippi Business
