## HOUSE BILL NO. 1233

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-21-117, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL FEE ON DIVORCE ACTIONS TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE FUND; TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 93-21-117, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

93-21-117. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 9 special fund to be known as the "Victims of Domestic Violence 10 Fund." The circuit clerks of the state shall deposit in such fund 11 on a monthly basis the additional fee charged and collected for 12 marriage licenses under the provisions of Section 25-7-13, 13 14 Mississippi Code of 1972. In addition, all other monies received from every source for the support of the program for victims of 15 domestic violence, established by Sections 93-21-101 through 16 93-21-113, shall be deposited in the "Victims of Domestic Violence 17 Fund." The monies in the fund shall be used by the State 18 Department of Health solely for funding and administering domestic 19 violence shelters under the provisions of Sections 93-21-101 20 through 93-21-113, in such amounts as the Legislature may 21 22 appropriate to the department for the program for victims of domestic violence established by Sections 93-21-101 through 23 93-21-113. Not more than ten percent (10%) of the monies in the 24 "Victims of Domestic Violence Fund" shall be appropriated to the 25 State Department of Health for the administration of domestic 26 27 violence shelters.

No. 1233 02/HR07/R1877 PAGE 1 (CJR\HS) In addition to any other fee collected for filing an action 28 for divorce in chancery court, there shall be an additional fee of 29 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) collected for each divorce action which 30 shall be remitted to the "Victims of Domestic Violence Fund." 31 32 These funds shall be for support of children's programs under the 33 operation and direction of any domestic violence shelter, defined in Section 93-21-101(b), and meeting the qualifications for 34 receiving state funding established by Sections 93-21-105 and 35 93-21-107. The divorce fee shall be collected by the chancery 36 clerks of the state and deposited to the fund on a monthly basis. 37 SECTION 2. Section 25-7-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 38 amended as follows: 39 25-7-9. For public service not otherwise specifically 86 (j) provided for, the chancery court may by order allow the clerk to 87 be paid by the county on the order of the board of supervisors, an 88 annual sum not exceeding..... 5,000.00 89 90 The chancery clerk shall itemize on the original document a detailed fee bill of all charges due or paid for filing, recording 91 92 and abstracting same. No person shall be required to pay such

93 fees until same have been so itemized, but said fees may be 94 demanded before the document is recorded.

In accordance with Uniform Chancery Court Rule 9.01 as 95 (2)96 approved by Order of the Mississippi Supreme Court, the following 97 fees shall be a total fee for all services performed by the clerk 98 with respect to a complaint which shall be payable upon filing and shall accrue to the chancery clerk at the time of filing. 99 The clerk or his successor in office shall perform all duties set 100 101 forth without additional compensation or fee to wit:

121 filing. An additional fee on divorce actions shall be paid as

122 provided in Section 93-21-117.

123 **SECTION 3**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 124 and after July 1, 2002.
