- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI, MISSISSIPPI 1 STATE UNIVERSITY, THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI AND JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY TO PLAY FOOTBALL AGAINST EACH OTHER ON A ROTATING BASIS SO THAT EACH UNIVERSITY PLAYS THE OTHERS EVERY 3 4
- 5 THREE YEARS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- of Higher Learning shall require the University of Mississippi, 8
- 9 Mississippi State University, the University of Southern
- Mississippi and Jackson State University to each compete in 10
- football against another university named in this section every 11
- year, beginning in the 2002 season. The games between these 12
- 13 universities shall rotate triennially so that each year during a
- 14 cycle of three (3) consecutive years, each school will compete
- against a university other than the universities against which the 15
- school competed during the preceding two (2) seasons. 16
- (2) This section may not be construed to prohibit the 17
- University of Mississippi, Mississippi State University, the 18
- 19 University of Southern Mississippi and Jackson State University
- from competing against more than one (1) other university named in 20
- this section during the same year. 21
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2002.
