HOUSE BILL NO. 1284

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE VENUE IN CIVIL ACTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 11-11-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 6 11-11-3. Civil actions of which the circuit court has
- 7 original jurisdiction shall be commenced in the county in which
- 8 the plaintiff, the defendant or any of them reside or in the
- 9 county where the cause of action may occur or accrue and, if the
- 10 plaintiff or defendant is a domestic corporation, in the county in
- 11 which $\underline{\text{the}}$ corporation is domiciled or in the county where the
- 12 cause of action may occur or accrue, except where otherwise
- 13 provided, and except actions of trespass on land, ejectment and
- 14 actions for the statutory penalty for cutting and boxing trees and
- 15 firing woods and actions for the actual value of trees cut which
- 16 shall be brought in the county where the land or some part thereof
- 17 is situated. If a civil action is brought in an improper county,
- 18 such action may be transferred to the proper county pursuant to
- 19 Section 11-11-17.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2002, but shall not affect actions commenced or
- 22 proceedings begun before July 1, 2002.
