COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1331

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-15-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE 2 RESOURCES FROM THE PUBLIC TRUST TIDELANDS FUND THAT ARE DESIGNATED 3 4 IN LINE ITEMS OF THE APPROPRIATION BILL FOR MANAGEMENT PROJECTS OR PUBLIC ACCESS PROJECTS SHALL NOT BE PAID TO AN ENTITY NAMED IN THE 5 BILL TO RECEIVE FUNDS FOR A DESIGNATED PROJECT UNTIL THE ENTITY 6 7 HAS MADE EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROJECT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Section 29-15-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 10 amended as follows: 29-15-9. (1) There is * * * created in the State Treasury a 11 special fund to be known as the "Public Trust Tidelands Fund." 12 The fund shall be administered by the Secretary of State as 13 14 trustee.

15 (2) Any funds derived from lease rentals of tidelands and submerged lands, except those funds derived from mineral leases, 16 or funds previously specifically designated to be applied to other 17 agencies, shall be transferred to the special fund. However, 18 funds derived from lease rentals may be used to cover the 19 20 administrative cost incurred by the Secretary of State. Any 21 remaining funds derived from lease rentals shall be disbursed pro rata to the local taxing authorities for the replacement of lost 22 23 ad valorem taxes, if any. Then, any remaining funds shall be disbursed to the commission for new and extra programs of 24 tidelands management, such as conservation, reclamation, 25 preservation, acquisition, education or the enhancement of public 26 access to the public trust tidelands or public improvement 27 28 projects as they relate to those lands.

Any funds appropriated to the Commission on Marine 29 (3) Resources or the Department of Marine Resources from the Public 30 Trust Tidelands Fund that are designated in line items of the 31 appropriation bill for management projects, public access projects 32 33 or public improvement projects, as authorized under subsection (2) of this section, shall not be paid to an entity named in the bill 34 to receive funds for a designated project until the entity has 35 submitted an invoice to the department indicating the work 36 performed and the detailed costs of the work. The commission or 37 department shall use the funds allocated in the bill for each 38 designated project to reimburse the entity named for that project 39 for expenditures made by the entity on the project. An entity may 40 be reimbursed from the appropriated funds only after the entity 41 has provided the commission or department with detailed written 42 invoices showing the amount and purpose of the expenditures for 43 which the entity is seeking reimbursement. 44 This act shall take effect and be in force from 45 SECTION 2.
