HOUSE BILL NO. 1354

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO IS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER OR WHO IS DISABLED SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR CANCELING OR 3 RESCINDING A CONTRACT FOR THE LEASE OR RENTAL OF RESIDENTIAL REAL 4 PROPERTY BEFORE EXPIRATION OF ITS TERM IF HE OR SHE HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TO BE IN NEED OF OR WOULD 5 BENEFIT FROM THE CARE OR SERVICES PROVIDED BY A NURSING HOME, 6 7 PERSONAL CARE HOME OR ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY AND HAS GIVEN AT LEAST 30 DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE PERSON WITH WHOM HE OR SHE HAS 8 CONTRACTED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 SECTION 1. (1) Any person who is sixty-five (65) years of
- 12 age or older, or who is disabled as determined by any state or
- 13 federal agency, and who has entered into any contract for the
- 14 lease or rental of real property used or to be used by such person
- 15 for residential purposes shall not be liable for canceling or
- 16 rescinding the contract before expiration of its term if:
- 17 (a) He or she has been determined by a health care
- 18 provider to be in need of or would benefit from the care or
- 19 services provided by a nursing home, personal care home or
- 20 assisted living facility; and
- 21 (b) He or she has given written notice to the person
- 22 with whom he or she contracted, or an agent or representative of
- 23 such person, at least thirty (30) days before cancellation or
- 24 rescission of the contract.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2002.
