## HOUSE BILL NO. 1371

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-505, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JASPER COUNTY TO PURCHASE CERTAIN OPTICAL MARK READING EQUIPMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-505, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

6 amended as follows:

7 23-15-505. The board of supervisors of any county in the

8 State of Mississippi and the governing authorities of any

9 municipality in the State of Mississippi are hereby authorized and

10 empowered, in their discretion, to purchase or rent optical mark

11 reading equipment used in an electronic voting system which meets

12 the requirements of Section 23-15-507 and may use such system in

13 all or a part of the precincts within its boundaries. It may

14 enlarge, consolidate or alter the boundaries of precincts where an

15 electronic voting system is used. The provisions of this chapter

16 shall be controlling with respect to elections where any OMR

17 system is used, and shall be liberally construed so as to carry

18 out the purpose of this chapter. The provisions of the election

19 law relating to the conduct of elections with paper ballots, that

20 are to be manually tabulated, insofar as they are applicable and

21 not in conflict with the efficient conduct of the systems, shall

22 apply.

The Board of Supervisors of Jasper County shall purchase

24 optical mark reading equipment to scan ballots at the polling

25 places, provided that such purchase is paid for out of federal

26 funds administered and made available through the office of the

27 Secretary of State.

28	SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
29	shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
30	or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
31	Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
32	District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
33	provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
34	extended.

35 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 37 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
