HOUSE BILL NO. 1377

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES THAT PLACE GRAVEL,  
2 SAND, SALT OR OTHER SUBSTANCES ON PUBLIC ROADWAYS TO MITIGATE  
3 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS TO REMOVE SUCH SUBSTANCES AFTER THE  
4 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS SUBSIDE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Whenever the state, any state agency, any  
7 political subdivision of the state or any other governmental  
8 entity places gravel, sand, salt or any other substance on a  
9 public road, street or highway, to prevent or mitigate adverse  
10 weather conditions, the entity that placed the substance on the  
11 road, street or highway shall remove the substance after the  
12 adverse weather conditions subside.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
14 and after July 1, 2002.
