## HOUSE BILL NO. 1382

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-7-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REQUIRE AN OFFENDER TO ALLOW A CORRECTIONAL FIELD OFFICER TO MAKE 2 CERTAIN SEARCHES AS A CONDITION OF POST-RELEASE SUPERVISION; AND 3 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. The courts referred to in Section 47-7-33 or 8 9 47-7-34 shall determine the terms and conditions of probation or post-release supervision and may alter or modify, at any time 10 during the period of probation or post-release supervision, the 11 conditions, and may include among them the following or any other: 12 That the offender shall: 13 Commit no offense against the laws of this or any (a) 14 other state of the United States, or of the United States; 15 Avoid injurious or vicious habits; 16 (b) 17 (C) Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful 18 character; (d) Report to the probation and parole officer as 19 directed; 20 21 (e) Permit the probation and parole officer to visit him at home or elsewhere; 22 Work faithfully at suitable employment so far as 23 (f) possible; 24 Remain within a specified area; 25 (q) 26 (h) Pay his fine in one (1) or several sums; Support his dependents; 27 (i)

Submit, as provided in Section 47-5-601, to any 28 (j) type of breath, saliva or urine chemical analysis test, the 29 purpose of which is to detect the possible presence of alcohol or 30 a substance prohibited or controlled by any law of the State of 31 32 Mississippi or the United States; (k) Permit the correctional field officer to search his 33 official residence or any automobile operated by the offender at 34 any time or place. 35 SECTION 2.
