HOUSE BILL NO. 1419
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 304 SPUR IN
2 TUNICA COUNTY AS THE "MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., MEMORIAL HIGHWAY";
3 TO DESIGNATE THE BRIDGE ON COWAN-LORRAINE ROAD IN HARRISON COUNTY
4 THAT SPANS THE HARRISON COUNTY INDUSTRIAL SEAWAY AS THE "EUGENE P.
5 WILKES MEMORIAL BRIDGE"; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF
6 MISSISSIPPI 570 IN THE CITY OF MCCOMB AS "VETERANS BOULEVARD"; TO
7 DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI 603 IN HANCOCK COUNTY
8 AS THE "STENNIS AIRPORT PARKWAY"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Mississippi Highway 304 Spur in Tunica
11 County is designated and shall be known as the "Martin Luther
12 King, Jr., Memorial Highway."

13 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
14 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
15 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

16 **SECTION 2.** (1) That bridge on Cowan-Lorraine Road in
17 Harrison County that spans the Harrison County Industrial Seaway
18 is designated and shall be known as the "Eugene P. Wilkes Memorial
19 Bridge."

20 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
21 and maintain an appropriate plaque at each end of the bridge, and
22 suitable markers along and approaching the bridge, reflecting its
23 name.

24 **SECTION 3.** (1) That portion of Smithdale Road (Mississippi
25 570) between Northwest Avenue and Enterprise Road in the corporate
26 limits of the City of McComb is designated and shall be known as
27 "Veterans Boulevard."

28 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
29 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
30 of roadway described in subsection (1) of this section.



31 **SECTION 4.** (1) That segment of Mississippi 603 in Hancock
32 County beginning at Interstate 10 and extending northerly to Kiln
33 is designated and shall be known as "Stennis Airport Parkway."

34 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
35 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
36 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section, including
37 signs on Interstate 10 designating the proper exit from Interstate
38 10 to Stennis International Airport if such signs are permitted
39 under applicable federal laws, rules and regulations.

40 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
41 and after its passage.
