AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 304 SPUR IN 1 TUNICA COUNTY AS THE "MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE THE BRIDGE ON COWAN-LORRAINE ROAD IN HARRISON COUNTY 2 3 4 THAT SPANS THE HARRISON COUNTY INDUSTRIAL SEAWAY AS THE "EUGENE P. WILKES MEMORIAL BRIDGE"; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF 5 MISSISSIPPI 570 IN THE CITY OF MCCOMB AS "VETERANS BOULEVARD"; TO 6 DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI 603 IN HANCOCK COUNTY 7 AS THE "STENNIS AIRPORT PARKWAY"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Mississippi Highway 304 Spur in Tunica 10 11 County is designated and shall be known as the "Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway." 12 The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 13 (2)and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment 14 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section. 15 SECTION 2. (1) That bridge on Cowan-Lorraine Road in 16 Harrison County that spans the Harrison County Industrial Seaway 17 is designated and shall be known as the "Eugene P. Wilkes Memorial 18 Bridge." 19 The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 20 (2) and maintain an appropriate plaque at each end of the bridge, and 21 suitable markers along and approaching the bridge, reflecting its 22 23 name. **SECTION 3.** (1) That portion of Smithdale Road (Mississippi 24 570) between Northwest Avenue and Enterprise Road in the corporate 25 limits of the City of McComb is designated and shall be known as 26 "Veterans Boulevard." 27 28 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment 29

(1) That segment of Mississippi 603 in Hancock 31 SECTION 4. County beginning at Interstate 10 and extending northerly to Kiln 32 is designated and shall be known as "Stennis Airport Parkway." 33 The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect 34 (2) 35 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment of highway described in subsection (1) of this section, including 36 signs on Interstate 10 designating the proper exit from Interstate 37 10 to Stennis International Airport if such signs are permitted 38 under applicable federal laws, rules and regulations. 39 SECTION 5.
