HOUSE BILL NO. 1427

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-142, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE THAT AN OFFENDER MAY RECEIVE A SENTENCE REDUCTION FOR 2 3 MODEL BEHAVIOR IN ADDITION TO REDUCTIONS FOR MERITORIOUS EARNED 4 TIME; TO PROVIDE THAT OFFENDERS PARTICIPATING IN THE MODEL BEHAVIOR INCENTIVE SENTENCE REDUCTION PROGRAM MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR 5 A REDUCTION OF SENTENCE OR A REDUCTION IN THE LEVEL OF 6 INCARCERATION, OR BOTH, SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE 7 COMMISSIONER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 10 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-142, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 11 amended as follows:

47-5-142. (1) In order to provide incentive for offenders 12 to achieve positive and worthwhile accomplishments for their 13 personal benefit or the benefit of others, and in addition to any 14 15 other administrative reductions of the length of an offender's sentence, any offender shall be eligible, subject to the 16 provisions of this section, to receive meritorious earned time or 17 18 model behavior incentive sentence reduction as distinguished from earned time for good conduct and performance. 19

(2) Subject to approval by the commissioner of the terms and
conditions of the program or project, meritorious earned time may
be awarded for the following: (a) successful completion of
educational or instructional programs; (b) satisfactory
participation in work projects; and (c) satisfactory participation
in any special incentive program.

26 (3) Additionally, subject to approval by the commissioner of
27 the terms and conditions of the program or project, there is
28 established a model behavior incentive reduction program under
29 which model behavior sentence reduction may be awarded for any of
30 the following: (a) community service; (b) assisting in behavior

31 modification of other offenders, such as steering fellow offenders

32 away from drugs and violence; (c) participation of any kind

33 involving exhibition of dedication toward improving community

34 conditions and attitudes of their fellowman.

35 <u>(4)</u> The programs and activities through which meritorious 36 earned time <u>or model behavior incentive sentence reduction</u> may be 37 received shall be published in writing and posted in conspicuous 38 places at all facilities of the department and such publication 39 shall be made available to all offenders in the custody of the 40 department.

41 (5) The commissioner shall make a determination of the number of days of reduction of sentence which may be awarded an 42 43 offender as meritorious earned time or model behavior incentive 44 sentence reduction for participation in approved programs or projects; the number of days shall be determined by the 45 commissioner on the basis of each particular program or project. 46 All offenders participating in the model behavior sentence 47 reduction program may be eligible for a reduction of sentence or 48 for a reduction in the level of incarceration, such as from jail 49 50 to house arrest, or both, subject to the discretion of the commission. Except as otherwise provided in this section, in no 51 52 event shall an offender be awarded in excess of ten (10) days reduction for each thirty (30) days of participation in such a 53 program or project. Furthermore, an offender shall never be 54 55 allowed to earn more than a total of one hundred eighty (180) days of meritorious earned time or model behavior incentive sentence 56 57 reduction during the entire time he is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections. The commissioner may authorize the 58 awarding of all or any part of meritorious earned time or model 59 behavior incentive sentence reduction upon an offender's entry 60

61 into the correctional system.

62 <u>(6)</u> No offender shall be awarded any meritorious earned time 63 <u>or model behavior incentive sentence reduction</u> while assigned to 64 the maximum security facilities for disciplinary purposes.

65 <u>(7)</u> All meritorious earned time <u>or model behavior incentive</u> 66 <u>sentence reduction</u> shall be forfeited by the offender in the event 67 of escape and/or aiding and abetting an escape.

68 (8) Any officer or employee of the department who shall 69 willfully violate the provisions of this section and be convicted 70 therefor shall be removed from office or employment.

71 (9) An offender may forfeit all or any part of his 72 meritorious earned time allowance <u>or model behavior incentive</u> 73 <u>sentence reduction</u> for just cause upon the written order of the 74 commissioner or his designee. Any meritorious earned time 75 allowance <u>or model behavior incentive sentence reduction</u> forfeited 76 under this section shall not be restored nor shall it be re-earned 77 by the offender.

78 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 and after July 1, 2002.
