- SECTION 1. Section 3-3-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6

- 3-3-15. Except as otherwise provided herein, the flag of the 8
- 9 United States of America and the official flag of the State of
- Mississippi as described in Section 3-3-16 shall be displayed in 10
- 11 close proximity to each state-owned building, and at office spaces
- occupied by state government in other buildings, from sunrise to 12
- sunset. The \* \* \* flags may be displayed from all public 13
- buildings other than state-owned buildings, from sunrise to 14
- sunset. The \* \* \* flags may be displayed from all public 15
- 16 buildings twenty-four (24) hours a day if properly illuminated.
- The \* \* \* flags should not be displayed when the weather is 17
- inclement, except when \* \* \* all-weather flags are displayed. 18 The
- official state flag shall receive all of the respect and 19
- ceremonious etiquette given the \* \* \* flag of the United States of 20
- America; however, nothing in this section shall be construed \* \* \* 21
- to affect the precedence given to the flag of the United States of 22
- 23 America.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24
- 25 and after July 1, 2002.
