HOUSE BILL NO. 1445 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF A COUNTY OR 1 2 MUNICIPALITY IN PRIMARY ELECTIONS AND THE COMMISSIONERS OF ELECTION OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY IN OTHER ELECTIONS TO APPOINT 3 4 NOT MORE THAN TWO STUDENTS AT EACH PRECINCT TO SERVE AS STUDENT INTERNS DURING ELECTIONS; TO SET CERTAIN MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS 5 FOR SUCH INTERNS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DUTIES OF SUCH INTERNS; TO 6 REQUIRE STUDENT INTERNS TO RECEIVE CERTAIN TRAINING; AND FOR 7 8 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 **SECTION 1.** (1) The officials in charge of the election in a 10 county or municipality may, in their discretion, appoint not more 11 than two (2) students for each precinct to serve as student 12 interns during elections. To be appointed a student intern a 13 student must: 14 (a) Be recommended by a principal or other school 15 official, or the person responsible for the student's legitimate 16 home instruction program; 17 Be at least sixteen (16) years of age at the time 18 (b) of the election for which the appointment is made; 19 Be a resident of the county or municipality for 20 (C) which the appointment is made; 21 Be enrolled in a public high school, an accredited (d)22 private high school or a legitimate home instruction program and 23 be classified as a junior or senior or its equivalent, or be 24 25 enrolled in a junior college or a college or university; and (e) Meet any additional qualifications considered 26 necessary by the officials in charge of the election in the county 27 28 or municipality. charge of the election in the county or municipality; however, 31 32 such duties shall not include: Determining the qualifications of a voter in 33 (i) case a voter is challenged; 34 35 (ii) The discharge of any duties related to affidavit ballots; 36 37 (iii) The operation and maintenance of any voting 38 equipment; (iv) Any duties normally assigned to a bailiff; or 39 The tallying of votes. 40 (v) (b) Student interns shall at all times be under the 41 supervision of the managers and clerks of the election while 42 43 performing their duties at precincts. Before performing any duties, student interns shall 44 (3) attend all required training for managers and clerks of the county 45 or municipality and any additional training considered necessary 46 by the officials in charge of the election in the county or 47 municipality. 48 As used in this section "officials in charge of the 49 (4)50 election" means the county or municipal executive committee, as appropriate, in primary elections and the county or municipal 51 52 election commission, as appropriate, in all other elections. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi SECTION 2. 53 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 54 55 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 56 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 57 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 58 59 extended.

60 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 61 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 62 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
