- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** It shall be unlawful for any law enforcement
- 6 officer to detain or stop a person in traffic based solely on the
- 7 race of the person being detained or stopped. All law enforcement
- 8 agencies shall keep accurate records of all traffic stops and
- 9 detentions identifying the reasons for the stops and the race of
- 10 the person being stopped or detained. Any law enforcement officer
- 11 who violates this section shall, upon conviction, be fined not
- 12 more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for up to
- 13 one (1) year, or both.
