HOUSE BILL NO. 1505

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS FROM CHARGING THEIR 1 CUSTOMERS A FEE FOR PROCESSING INSURANCE DRAFTS PAYABLE TO THE 2 3 CUSTOMER FOR DAMAGE SUSTAINED IN A NATURAL DISASTER; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. (1) A financial institution shall not charge a 6 fee to a customer of the financial institution for cashing, 7 handling or processing a draft from an insurance company that is 8 9 payable to the customer for damage sustained by the customer in a natural disaster, such as a hurricane, flood, tornado, wind, ice 10 storm or earthquake. 11 As used in this section, the following terms shall have 12 (2)the following meanings: 13 "Customer" means an individual who has a checking (a) 14 or savings account at a financial institution. 15 "Financial institution" means: 16 (b) 17 (i) Any bank, savings association, savings and loan association, savings bank or credit union incorporated under 18 the laws of the State of Mississippi that offers checking or 19 20 savings accounts to Mississippi residents; (ii) Any bank, savings association, savings and 21 loan association or credit union incorporated under the laws of 22 the United States and having an office in Mississippi that offers 23 checking or savings accounts to Mississippi residents; and 24 (iii) Any bank, savings association, savings and 25 26 loan association, savings bank or credit union incorporated under the laws of another state and having an office in Mississippi that 27 offers checking or savings accounts to Mississippi residents. 28 H. 29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 30 and after July 1, 2002.
